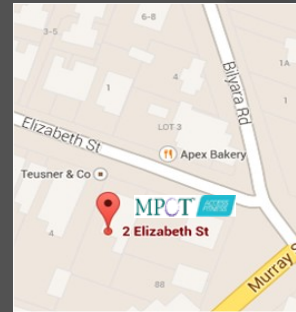
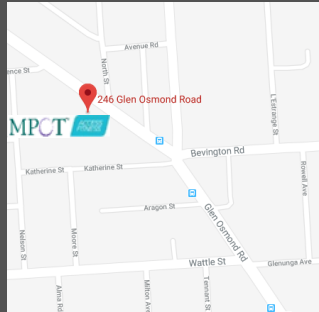

SAAPRAS understands that people undergoing the physical and emotional demands of amputee surgery need to be supported by a service that enhances their functional potential and independence whilst being flexible, timely and efficient.

Prosthetic Rehabilitation

Pre-Operative Planning

- Home review and assessment
- Collaboratively planning an early safe return home
- Education and support for clients and family/carer
- Fitness for surgery to optimise recovery and rehabilitation

Post Operative Services

- Goal setting collaboratively with the client and rehabilitation team
- Liaison with treating practitioner and other community services to support rehabilitation and return to work
- Prosthetic working closely with PROSTEK to get the best outcome possible
- Management to prevent contractures, controlling of residual limb volume changes and pain management
- Monitoring for any complications or potential risk

Ongoing Management and Support

- Reintegration into the community
- Driving assessments
- Return to work and the community

PROSTEK Prosthetists

- Monitor ongoing fit and function
- Make adjustments as needed
- Provide education on protecting the residual and contra-lateral limb from trauma and adapting to new lifestyle changes

MPOT/Access Fitness Occupational Therapist

- Complete reviews at home to finalise suitable equipment and progress day to day independence.
